## Order Your ECC Club Kit – Update

An order has been placed for several 'test' kits so we can examine the colours, logos, text etc, just to be sure, to be sure.

These should be available by early April. Once we are satisfied all is well the main order will be placed, and we will expect to take delivery 6 - 8 weeks later. The cut-off date is 10 April. If you have placed your order by then yours will be part of the first delivery (end of May/early June).

**STOP PRESS:** Long sleeve jerseys have been added to the range with a choice of light-weight lycra or warmer fleece-lined jerseys.

The design has changed minimally (cuff colours), but we believe the quality is even better, and the price is around 20% less (\$229 for Jersey/Knicks). The range includes long and short sleeve jerseys, bib and non-bib Knicks, wind vests, arm warmers, single piece speed suits, and caps.

Sizing - John Williams has samples of the kit in men's sizing from XS to XXXL (in Blackburn CC colours). He will bring them to races for members to inspect and try for size. We would prefer women to discuss their specific sizing needs with Doug Reynolds on 0418 382 330 so we can get the size just right.

We have the first kit on order as a trial to ensure the production matches expectations. We are





hoping to have that in our hands by end of April. In the meantime the website is open for orders, but the production order will not be placed on the factory until we are happy with that first sample. From there we expect a 6 week lead time, meaning first delivery in July.

VeloEx, run by ECC member Doug Reynolds, provided the club with great versatility with small orders (most suppliers insist minimum order of 50), a great website and competitive pricing. In addition, if you wreck your kit in a fall, VeloEx will replace it at 40% discount.

So let's get it on!

Riders who enter a handicap *must* pay the entry fee regardless of whether they participate. No late entries will be accepted for either scratch races or handicaps. Entries to handicaps can be submitted to the handicapper via email or TeamApp, or on any race day before the event.




Wednesday racing at the Teardrop/Loop is still cash on the day with registration closing at 10:00 am and a start time of 10:15 am. Cost is \$4 in coins or a \$5 note. No change is offered due to ECC Covid-Safe procedures.

#### Eastern CC Snooze Nunawading Handicap – Entries are now closed

With around 70 entrants this one is shaping up to be a great day out. See below for registration, course and race details.







#### Pre-amble:

- Registrations & parking in public area on Manners Street, across the road from the Royal Hotel (see map above).
- Registration is approx 6k from the race start so allow yourself time to register, set up and ride to the start.
- Public toilets are available just down Manners Street (200m). There are no toilets at race start/finish area.
- Coffee and hot food is available at a roadside café on the corner of Goulburn Valley Highway and Manners Street.
- Presentations will be in the Royal Hotel beer garden, buy a drink on your way through.

#### Race circuit:


- Rider briefing/race start is 2k along the Seymour Avenel Road (grey pin, top right of map above), 6k from the
  registration area
- This is an out and back circuit
- The race proceeds straight up the Seymour Avenel Road for 14k (through Avenel), completes a U-turn and returns to the start finish to complete the lap.
- The above equates to a 28k lap, all riders will complete 2 laps = 56k

The road will be controlled for the finish, there is approximately a 400m straight line sprint to the finish, riders are able to use both sides of the road for the sprint, <u>however</u>riders are not to cross to the right-hand side of the road until they are <u>CERTAIN</u> that there is no traffic between them and the finish line.

It is **your RESPONSIBILITY** to ensure it is safe to cross to the right hand side of the road before you do so. A vehicle may have passed the traffic controller before you are seen and the TC has had the opportunity to stop the traffic.

A driver may ignore the traffic controller's instructions.
