Hello (old Vets) cycling clubs and other cycling friends,

please see our summer/autumn calendar for Eureka Cycling Club - kicks off the 2022 racing season on Sunday.

Eureka will be encouraging members to compete in feature events hosted by our sister clubs! Eureka Open Day is scheduled for October and will include a Men's Open and a Women's Open.

Note that the Sth Pacific Championships is now a three day event. (Easter Saturday to Monday). The Individual Time Trial (at Learmonth) on Easter Saturday is a new event for the Eureka Easter Carnival.

Graded Criterium races will be staged at Victoria Park (Ballarat) on Easter Sunday. On Easter Monday (at Learmonth) we will be staging a road race (handicap) for Men and a road race (handicap) for Women. The road races finish atop a 1.8 Km climb which has previously featured in the State Veteran Road Race Championships.

Eureka is also proud to announce the Ray Hodgson Classic at Myrniong on Saturday 7th May. We hope that this Saturday date will ensure high numbers at the Eureka event and also the Northern Cycling Mother's Day Charity event - Tracey Romans Memorial - the following day.

Eligible Masters riders are welcome to compete at regular Eureka club events. Visitors are also welcome at the Eureka Time Trial Championship - which is a FREE entry race however ONLY qualified Eureka members may claim prizes.

May our 2022 racing seasons be uninterrupted!


